### **GRADES: SIX THROUGH TWELVE**

T-Shirts with crew neck

Pants and shorts, including denim, must not sag

Shirts with sleeves, shoulders must be covered

Shorts, skirts and/or dresses must come to the knee

Leggings may be worn under knee length skirt or dress

#### TOP LAYER MUST BE IN DRESS CODE FOR ALL GRADE LEVELS.

NO Side or Front Slits

**NO** Sweat Pants

### **UNACCEPTABLE DRESS**

Head Covering

Hair curlers or rollers

Low-cut or see through clothing

Spandex

Shirts that are too short to stay in

Sleeveless Dresses, or shirts and dresses with cap sleeves

Flip-Flops/thongs, no backless shoes

## Coats, jackets, shirts, and sweatshirts, tape paper or any other material used to cover, hide or obscure dress code violations

NO logos that promote drugs, alcohol, tobacco, sex, or violence

Clothing with holes
